
2012 FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Total revenues for Calendar Year 2012 (CY12) were \$11.9 million.



A value cannot be placed on the contributions of our global community of partners and volunteers. We are truly grateful for their generous and compassionate hearts to help the world's most vulnerable people.



EXPENDITURES*

70.2% of CY12 expenditures were for direct program costs. Total expenditures for CY12 were 12.8 million. At the end of CY12, HOPE *worldwide's* ending net assets were \$4.66 million.

HOPE *worldwide* hopes to attract additional funding in future years to invest in capacity building to sustain the organization's continued growth in services to the poor and needy.
